

Street Listing Form Instructions

After reading the instructions, please fill out the Street Listing Form you received by mail and return within 14 days. If you did not receive a form please contact this office and one will be provided. (978-346-8013 or townclerk@townofmerrimac.com)

Please Do the Following when filling out the Form:

1. Report all the children residing in the home. **Children's Information IS NOT A PUBLIC RECORD** and will not appear on the street listing; however it is an important figure for school projections and State School Aid.
2. If a Family Member is currently serving in the Military or away at college, **unless that individual has established residency elsewhere, DO NOT REMOVE THEM FROM YOUR RESIDENCE, BUT CONTINUE TO LIST THEM AS RESIDENTS IN THE HOME.** This will ensure a residency for voting and to provide proof of residency for many Veterans' Benefits, including the Welcome Home Bonus.
3. If a letter does not appear in the "Party" column of the form, then that individual is **NOT REGISTERED TO VOTE IN MERRIMAC. You cannot use this form to register to vote or to change your party.** If you wish a registration form mailed to you, please indicate this on the form and I will provide one. Voter registration forms may also be found at the Library and Council on Aging.

Please understand that information provided is important to the Town and to you.

It provides the Town with the ability to keep the voter list current and accurate, is needed for school population projections and government representation.

For you it can mean the proof of residency needed for reduced tuition at State Colleges and Universities, or entry to Whittier Tech or Essex Aggie and the ability to receive housing, veteran's benefits or other government benefits.

The forms may be returned by mail, dropped off at Town Hall or in dropped in specially marked boxes at the Library or Senior Center. So please return the forms as soon as possible and help the town avoid the additional expense of follow-up notices or calls.
